What's happening now:

Things you should know:

- Itinerary for the class trip is on the back of this page, please take a moment to review it. The trip is scheduled for Saturday, January 29th. We meet up at MAST at 4:30 am and return to MAST around 11:30pm-12:00am the same day.
- When we return from Winter Break, there will be a group sign-up sheet for students attending the trip. Students will have the opportunity to sign up to be part of a group of 3-6 students. During our visit to Orlando, students must be with their group at all times—no student should ever be alone.
- Chaperone and bus assignments will be posted by Ms. Jimenez's door closer to the trip.

On trip day, students should:

- Be appropriately dressed, abiding by MAST Academy's ship shape dress code. Any student not in dress code will be sent home and not allowed to attend the trip.
- Have money for lunch and dinner, as well as any souvenirs or snacks they may choose to purchase. Suggested amount of money to have on-hand: \$50-\$75. Also plus save \$1-2 to tip our bus drivers.
- Charge their phone prior to the trip, in order to maintain contact with peers and chaperones throughout the trip.
- Behave according to MAST Manners and listen to instructions from chaperones the first time given.
- Be responsible for any belongings they bring on the trip.

Updated Safety Guidelines

The health and safety of our guests and team members is always our top priority. As a result, face coverings will now be required, effective Friday, December 24, 2021, at all public indoor locations within Universal Orlando Resort for both guests and team members regardless of vaccination status - including restaurants, shops, and indoor hotel public areas. - Guests are expected to bring a face covering with them for their visit
- We do not require proof of vaccinations
- We remain focused on maintaining the highest cleanliness and sanitization standards

Each guest must confirm the following before visiting:

- You are not feeling sick or experiencing flu-like symptoms such as Fever and/or
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Chills
 - Muscle pain
 - Sore throat
 - New loss of taste or smell
- You have not been in contact with someone with known or suspected COVID-19 symptoms
- You are not under any self-quarantine orders

Face covering guidelines
