ALL EVENING EVENT TICKETS ARE NON-TRANSFERABLE

The dress code for the evening is semi-formal and applies to all attendees. The purchaser of the ticket is responsible for informing his or her guest of the dress and behavioral codes and will be held responsible if his or her guest does not conform to these codes. Students who are denied entrance or ejected from the event will not be issued a refund. Evening events are nonrefundable and not transferrable.

Dress Code Guidelines

- Dress shirt with or without a tie. Tank Tops, t-shirts or casual tops are NOT allowed- short sleeve dress shirts may be worn to outdoor events. Dress pants are allowed. Jeans, shorts or casual pants are NOT allowed.
- Appropriate dress shoes or dress sandals are recommended- sneakers may be worn to outdoor events.
- Baseball caps, headbands, bandanas, skullies, scarves, and hats of any kind are NOT allowed.
- Dresses that are strapless or with spaghetti straps are allowed.
- Dresses made from see-through fabric are NOT allowed.
- Backless dresses are allowed if they do not expose skin below the waist.
- Two-piece dresses are allowed if the rib and abdominal area are covered.
- Slits on dresses may be no higher than mid-thigh. No excessively short skirts are permitted.
- Necklines should be appropriate for a school-sponsored dance. V-necks may not be lower than the breastbone.
- Printed inappropriate messages will not be allowed on clothing

All attendees must present a **valid picture ID** and MAST ACADEMY evening event ticket at the registration table before entering. Either a **school ID** or a **valid driver's license** may be used. **If you do not have ID, you will not be allowed to enter.** Once you exit the ballroom, you may not return.

Only MAST Academy students may purchase tickets. Dates who do not attend MAST Academy must be in a high school or, at most, 19 years old at the time of the event.

No alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, tobacco products or mood modifiers are permitted either before or during the event.

STUDENTS WHO DO NOT ADHERE TO THE GUIDELINES PRESENTED HEREIN WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE EVENT AND WILL BE SUBJECT TO ARREST AND DISCIPLINARY ACTION BY THE SCHOOL, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, SUSPENSION AND NOT ATTENDING FUTURE EVENTS. THE ADMINISTRATION RESERVES THE RIGHT TO EXCLUDE OR EXPEL ANY PERSON FROM THE EVENT WHO APPEARS TO BE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF DRUGS AND/OR ALCOHOL.
