AP Spanish Language & Culture	 <p><i>Bendiceme, Última</i> by Rudolfo Anaya</p> <p>Purchase a new or used copy (in SPANISH) of Rudolfo Anaya's <i>Bendiceme, Última</i> (Grand Central Publishing, 1994). Read the first TEN chapters of the novel with a pencil or pen at hand and mark passages that you find compelling or that you have a question about. You should also circle the occasional vocabulary word that you don't understand. In addition to carefully reading the first ten chapters, you will be creating a quote journal for the novel. Choose ten quotes from the book which you find meaningful or thought-provoking. Copy each (by hand) on a separate sheet of paper. Below the quote, write your own commentary, interpretation and/or questions (<i>en español, por favor—y cuidado con la ortografía y la gramática</i>). Bring your neatly written pages to class the first day of school.</p>
