

# **Your K-12 EASY Card**



#### It's EASY!

- Plan your route on the MDT Tracker app or <u>www.miamidade.gov/transit</u>
- Parents can also use this app to track student trips as an added security feature.
- 'Tap in' the card at a Metrorail faregate or Metrobus farebox and ride (bring a school ID) 'Tap out' at any Metrorail station (no need to tap out when exiting the bus).

### **Benefits and savings**

- Passes are pre-loaded with two trips per weekday (including transfers) to and from school courtesy of Miami-Dade County Public Schools in partnership with the Department of Transportation & Public Works.
- Additional passes or cash value can be added to the card online at <u>transitstore.miamidade.gov</u>, by visiting any EASY Card Vending Machine located at Metrorail stations, or any EASY Card Sales Outlet.
- Students with a K-12 EASY Card ride for half the regular cost. Fares are available online.

## **Participation in the Program**

- The pass provided to you can only be used by you. Sharing, loaning, or allowing anyone
  else to use your assigned pass will result in a loss of privileges in the program.
   (Metro Transit reserves the right to confiscate your card).
- Failure to complete the **FEFP** (*Florida Education Finance Program*), documents correctly during the survey periods, will result in a loss of funding until the next survey period.
- If your card has not been used for **30** days, it will be disabled.
- If your pass is lost or stolen, you will need to report it and purchase another card directly from an Easy Card Sales Outlet located at the Overtown or Government Center Stations and provide the new Easy Card number to your school so that funds can be transferred.

### \*\*ATTENTION\*\* This is NOT an "unlimited" trip card

Doing the following, will cause you to run out of funds before the end of the month.

- Using your card beyond the two pre-loaded trips to and from school, per day.
- Using your card on weeknights, weekends, non-school days, school recess or holidays.
- Using your card on the tri-rail.

\*You will be responsible for the cost of your transportation, should you run out of funds before then end of the month.
